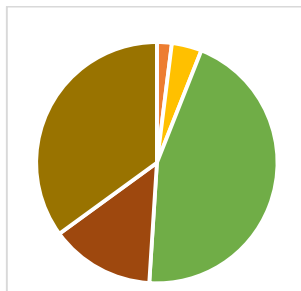
## ...TO OUR HOMEBOUND NEIGHBORS.

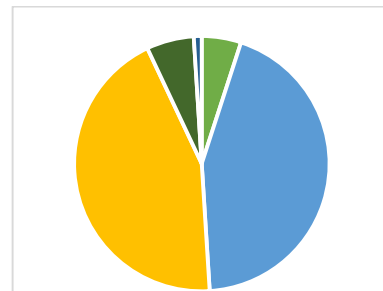
### By Race/Ethnicity

### By Generation

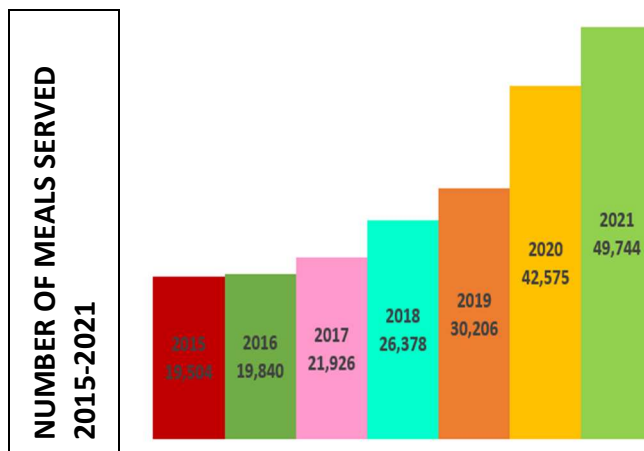
